

Summer Gymnastics Registration Starts May 5 for Oak Park Residents!

It's hard to believe that spring is on its way and that summer is right

around the corner but we are working hard to make summer registration a smooth process. **SUMMER REGISTRATION** is on a first come, first served basis giving priority to Oak Park residents.

- May 5 at 10am for Oak Park residents
- May 7 at 10am for non-residents

Online registration will close on June 1st for both residents and non-residents. After June 1st, registration will only be taken in person at the Gymnastics and Recreation Center (GRC) located at 21 Lake Street. You will receive detailed instructions about the registration process along with information regarding which class level your child should sign up for in mid-April. Class schedules will also be available on our website at pdop.org. If you do not have access to the internet or would prefer to register in person, you will be able to do so beginning at the same times as listed above for online registration. We want to stress that there is no advantage to in person registration as the registrars will be using the same system. Our customer service representatives (located at 21 Lake Street) will be available to input your registration until June 1st when online registration closes.

PLEASE NOTE! A few key things to help you prepare for summer registration:

- You will need a household user name and password to register online. If you don't have one or know what it is, go to www.pdop.org, click the registration tab (last tab on top of page) and follow the directions. If you need help, contact customer service at 708-725-2200. - Our summer schedule is broken into 2 four week sessions. You can register for either session or both. When registering, please be careful to use the correct activity code(s).

- If the class you want to register for is full, you must call the gymnastics center to get on a waitlist. Waitlists will not be part of the online process. Please call 708-725-2200 and provide us with the following information; child's name (please spell name), class level, class day and time (you can be on multiple waitlists), child's date of birth and the best phone number to contact you.

Refunds must be requested <u>before</u> a program meets for the second time or no refund will be issued for the remaining classes. A \$10 service fee will be charged for each gymnastics class cancelled. A \$25 service fee will be charged for all gymnastics camp refund requests.
