Weaknesses


- Changing facilities

- Excessive depth of diving well




















5. WHAT AREAS OF REHM POOL WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE IMPROVED?



7. PLEASE RANK THE AQUATIC IMPROVEMENTS IN ORDER OF PREFERENCE.




8. PLEASE RANK THE AMENITY GROUPS IN ORDER OF PREFERENCE






What do we mean when we say inclusive locker rooms?

- Individual rooms are zoned similarly to the graphic.







| Total | \$7,480,000 | - | \$8,260,000 |
|----------------------------|-------------|---|-------------|
| Miscellaneous Improvements | \$160,000 | - | \$180,000 |
| Splash Pad | \$1,440,000 | - | \$1,590,000 |
| Recreation Pool | \$2,410,000 | - | \$2,660,000 |
| Bathhouse Renovation | \$3,470,000 | - | \$3,840,000 |

^{*}Costs are Total Project Costs escalated to 2026 dollars



Next Steps

- Park District to pursue PARC Grant Funding
- Establish design and construction schedule dependent upon outcome of grant funding

- Monitor reception, use, and operations of inclusive locker room and restroom concepts at the Community Recreation Center
- Re-visit inclusive locker rooms as part of design process once engaged
