The Park District of Oak Park was the 2015 recipient of the National Gold Medal Award for excellence in park and recreation management. The Gold Medal is the most prestigious award in the parks and recreation industry. This year, the Park District of Oak Park is once again a finalists for this prestigious award. The winner will be announced in September.

In 2020, the Park District also earned re-accreditation through the Commission for Accreditation of Park and Recreation Agencies (CAPRA) and the National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA).

The Park District is only one of six park and recreation agencies in the State of Illinois to win the Gold Medal and earn both State and National Accreditation.

Dedicated Volunteers Make a Difference

During 2020, as the Covid-19 pandemic turned our world upside down, a very dedicated group of volunteers shared their time, talent, and expertise with the Park District of Oak Park.
