The Park District of Oak Park Infinite Style Synchronized Skating Team is a competitive synchronized skating program based out of Ridgeland Common Recreation Complex. The season begins in early September and runs through March, culminating in the Park District of Oak Park Ice Show. Potential practice and event times are listed below, but are subject to expand or change. Whether this is your first season with Infinite Style, or your 10th, please read through the entire packet to ensure you know what to expect this fall. Open Juvenile is open to skaters ages 18 and younger.

The goal for the Open Juvenile team is to further develop and refining skating skills, while bonding as a team unit. Skaters work to become a strong team through a focus on communication, positivity and confidence.

Park District of Oak Park Skill Requirements for Infinite Style Synchronized Skating Team

All team members are required to be enrolled in a Skate Academy class, passed Freeskate 4 or higher class by September 7, 2024, and be 7-18 years old by July 1, 2024. Skaters must adhere to the expectations outlined below and adhere to the Infinite Style Code of Conduct. Additionally, skaters must feel confident performing the following skills:

- Strong forward stroking
- Strong forward and backward pumps, both clockwise and counter-clockwise direction on the circle
- Forward and backward two-foot turns on the circle
- Forward and backward crossovers left and right both clockwise and counter-clockwise directions
- Forward outside and inside edges, left and right
- Forward and backward chasses, left and right
- Forward lunges left and right
- Forward straight-line spiral, left and right
- T-stops, left and right
- Rockers, Counters, Brackets

Encouraged Additional Ice Time:

- Private lessons strengthen skaters' skating and help advance their skill level but are not required to participate on the Infinite Style team(s).
- Take advantage of Skate School practice and Freestyle time offered to all skaters in the program. Times are posted online under Freestyle Ice/Skate School Practice.

Infinite Style Skater Expectations

Attendance and Punctuality

Skaters are required to arrive at least 15 minutes before every scheduled practice. Skaters must alert a coach of any expected absences minimally 24 hours before practice. Synchronized Skating is a team sport and missing practices will negatively affect your teammates.

Attendance is <u>mandatory</u> two weeks prior to any event or competition. No exceptions. Missing practice during that timeframe will disqualify skaters from said competition without refund.

Practice Attire

- Skaters are required to wear the provided practice attire during all practices. This attire includes an infinite style t-shirt and black pants or Infinite Style track outfit.
- Skaters may also wear their Infinite Style skating jacket if desired.
- All hair longer than chin length must be pulled away from the face and secured.
- Skaters must bring a full water bottle to practice.

Competition Attire

- Skaters are required to wear their competition costume and Infinite Style Team jacket to all competitions.
- Skaters may wear their Infinite Style pants over their costume if desired if the pants will not cause damage to the costume. (Discussed on a year-to-year basis.)
- Skaters must bring their skate their Infinite Style tote bag (provided).
- Skaters are responsible for their own belongings; all attire must be well cared for and clean for each event. Skaters must label all pieces with their name and phone number to prevent loss.

Family Commitment

The Infinite Style synchro team is not comprised of just skaters—your entire family will become part of the team experience. Please help your skater understand the importance of their commitment to the team and support them throughout the season. Please remain flexible if sudden changes to the schedule should arise throughout the season. All team staff are working their hardest to communicate and make the season go well. Throughout the year, you may be asked to volunteer for events. If so, thank you in advance for your creativity, time, and especially your patience.

LTS Membership Number: All skaters must register with Learn to Skate USA each year. Basic membership is included in Skate Academy registration. The

team will need to provide membership numbers of all skaters to register for competitions. Please include your skaters updated number.

Highest Basic Skills Level Passed: Enter the highest level your skater has passed in the Learn to Skate Academy.

Highest Moves in the Field Passed: If your skater has passed any of their moves in the field, indicate the highest.

Skate Bag: Indicate whether your skater would like to order an Infinite Style skate bag. This is an additional fee and not required to participate on the team.

Measurements: Please take new measurements of your skater each year. Coaches will use these measurements to order practice attire as well as skating jackets and competition costumes.

How To Properly Measure:

A)Bust/Chest: Measure the fullest part of the bust keeping tape measure parallel to the floor.

B) Waist: Measure at natural waistline

wast. Measure at natural wastine (the most narrow part of torso).

C) Hips: Measure around the fullest part of the lower body including bottom.

D) Girth: Measure from top of shoulder down center front through the crotch and up the back to the starting point.

E) Inseam: Measure inside the leg from crotch to the ankle.
